TREE TU BISHVAT TIDBITS:

- The bracha (blessing) for fruit of the tree is 1. HA'ETZ
- On Tu Bishvat it is a custom to eat a new 2. fruit and make the bracha of SHEHECHEYANU.
 - For anything that grows on the ground or a bush that dies in the winter (e.g. strawberries, melon, pineapple, bananas, blackberries) we say the bracha HA'ADAMA.
