

One of those servicemen was Mark Kosky, who served in the RAF during World War II. He completed two tours of duty with the Lancaster Bombers when surviving even one was unlikely! Before every flight he would recite Psalm 16 which starts "Guard me, God, for I have sought refuge in you." His crew were very impressed with this and eventually they refused to fly until they knew Kosky had said his prayer. Mark Kosky went on to be an active member in his Jewish community, serving in many leadership positions in the United Synagogue and pioneering the concept of youth services.
