PINCHAS: WE LOVE THE LAND!



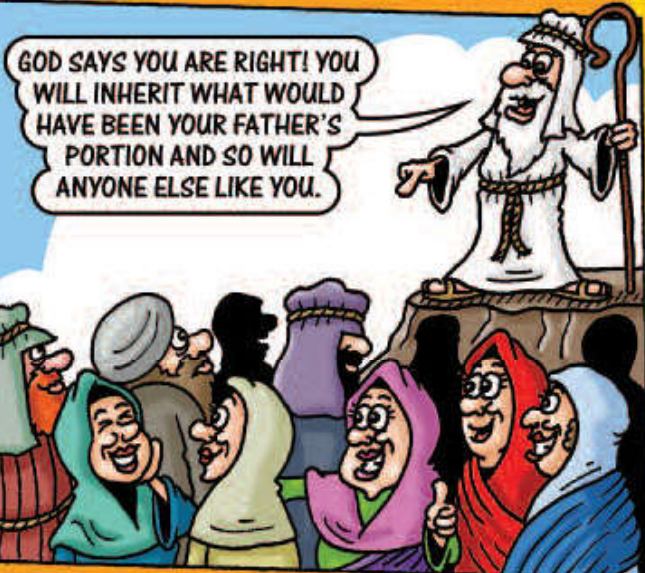
