# WHO IS RESPONSIBLE?



This question can make us very afraid or extremely proud. It depends on whether we are being held accountable for something negative or celebrated for something good.

We think of Pesach as the festival of freedom. However, this freedom only came about through people stepping up to the plate and taking **responsibility**. The Pesach story was miraculously orchestrated by God, with the partnership of human beings who had to play their role in making it happen.

In case freedom from slavery could be mistaken for the right to act without conscience, all the heroes of the exodus were people who took responsibility and stood out from the crowd. The midwives who saved Jewish babies, Pharaoh's daughter who ironically became the preserver of the life that Pharaoh was so anxious to eliminate, as well as Moses taking up the mantle of leadership, are just a few examples.

**The Tribe Exodus Files** charts the value of responsibility through the journey of the Jewish people in and out of Egypt. Try to identify the mystery characters involved, discuss how their acts of responsibility altered the course of history and reflect on how we deal with the art of responsibility in our own lives.

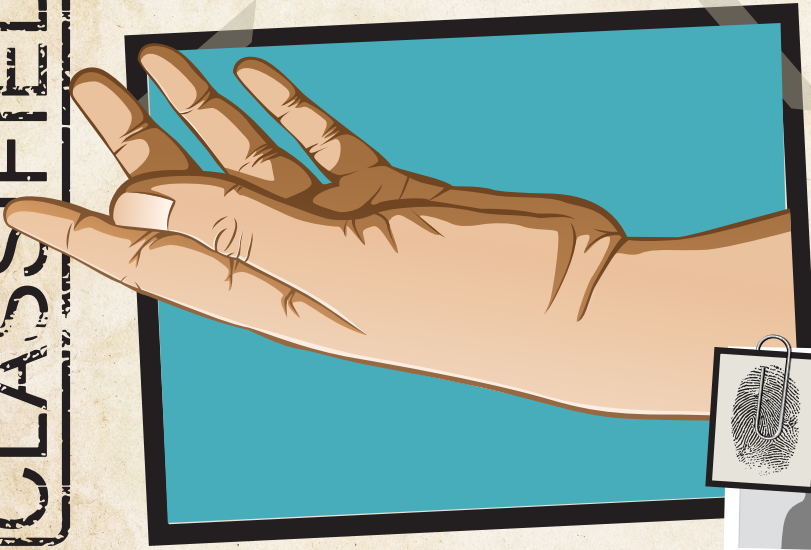

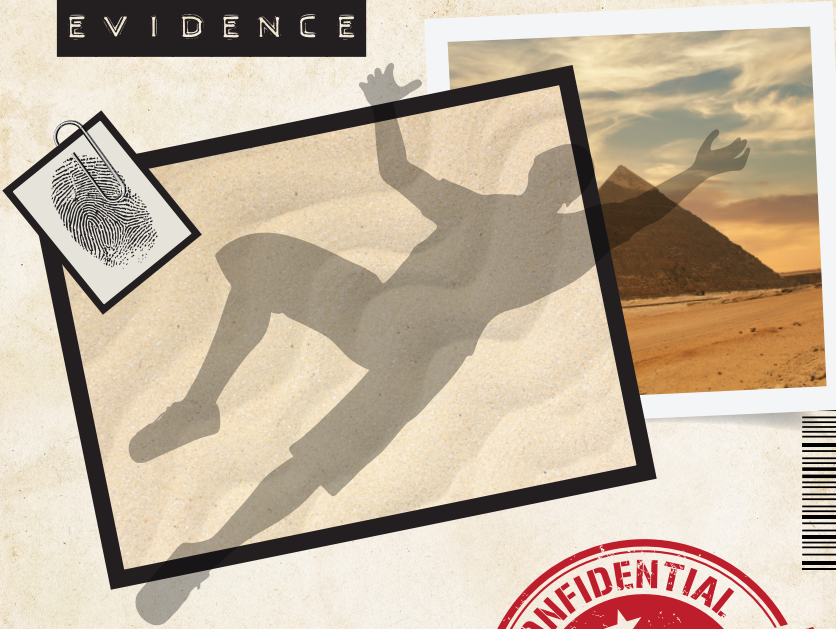
