



Tribe Find Tishrei Talent

Over the past few weeks Tribe have been grilling primary school pupils in years 5 and 6 on their Jewish general knowledge in their annual Tishrei's Got Talent quiz. The informal educational programme, which has been running for several years, splits a year group up into teams who compete to see who knows the most about the month of Tishrei.

Pupils at Moriah, Rosh Pinah, Sacks Morasha, Sinai and Wolfson Hillel primary schools were put to the test through several rounds including longest shofar blowing, pin the etrog on the lulav and a special Tishrei puzzle.
