This week's Parasha mentions all the **Chagim** - festivals. The evil Dr Tisoris has shredded the Jewish calendar. Dan and Dina are trying to remember when each **Chag** is and which object is connected to it. See the clues below to help them work out the date of each **Chag** and the matching object.



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CLUES

- Dan loves eating Matzah on Pesach which is not in Sivan.
- Yom Kippur, which is on the 10th of the month, falls at a busy time of year for Chagim.
- Dina can't wait to hear the Shofar on the Chag that is on the first of the month.
- The Chag in Sivan is a celebration of receiving the Torah.
- Dina will wave her Arba Minim on the third festival in Tishrei.
- We pray all day from a Machzor on the 10th of the month.
- Succot is on the 15th of the month.
- We don't eat Matzah in the month full of Chagim.
- Dan is excited that Rosh Hashana, Yom Kippur and Succot are all in the same month.
