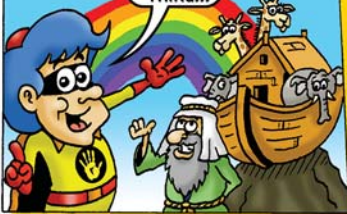




THE TRIBE SCRIBE

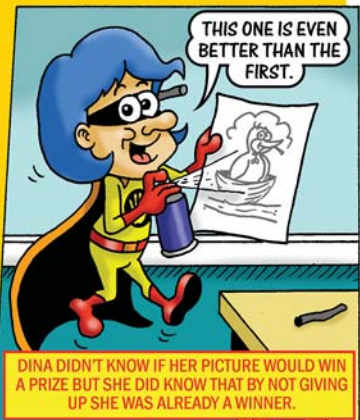
BY THE TIME SHE GOT BACK TO HER PICTURE IT WAS A WHILE LATER...
