SCOPE OF JOB

JOB PURPOSE

The successful applicant(s) will have the energy and passion to take on the critical job of building our youth community, to inspire new friendships and to encourage individuals to come together to celebrate their Jewish identity.

1. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- To work closely with the lay and religious leadership of Barnet United Synagogue.
- To foster relationships with young people and families in the community and encourage their participation in youth activities.
- Attendance on alternating Shabbats is required, and availability on other Shabbats and chaggim will be open to discussion.
- To create and then develop a supporting team of youth volunteers from the community to assist in creating and implementing the experiences.

- Excellent computer skills and working knowledge of social media.
- Ability to encourage others.
- Flexible approach to working hours.
